

FLC Council has approved the following regathering recommendations until further notice.

- Continue the use of masks/face coverings while worshipping indoors. The overreaching rationale for this is to provide for the safety of our children/younger population who are not yet eligible for a COVID-19 vaccination.
- Resume singing and other speaking aloud by the congregation.
- Remove the requirement for advance reservations and capacity limits in worship spaces to the extent practical.
- No seating assignments shall be made. Persons are free to sit and space as they feel comfortable.
- Require attendance be taken upon entry and secure a contact phone number for any person not already on file.
- Continue the use of individual, prepackaged communion kits and provide for individual bulletins in traditional worship.
- Worship leaders may speak or sing without the use of a face covering given their distance from others.
- Entrance and exit to the building will be limited to the use of entrance A for traditional worship and entrance C for contemporary worship.
- No other indoor activities should resume on Sunday mornings at this time.
- Continue to livestream worship services via Facebook.

Other public use of the building (not worship or programs related) shall be limited to FLC member groups/ministries, Monday – Thursday, 8 am to 1:00 pm, and a staff member is on site. Currently, only the use of the Community Center may be reserved.
